Rudolph Valentino

Valentino was born **Rodolfo Alfonso Raffaello Piero Filiberto Guglielmi** in Castellaneta, Italy.

In 1913, Valentino left for New York City. He arrived with about \$20,000 which he promptly wasted. After a period on the streets, he eventually supported himself with odd jobs such as busing tables in restaurants, even trying his hand at gardening. Eventually he found work as a taxi dancer and instructor, and later as an exhibition dancer which was the craze at the time. He gained attention for his rendition of the Argentine tango. Valentino was one of the most popular stars of the 1920s and is one of the best remembered actors from the silent movie era. Some of his best known roles include *The Sheik* and *The Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse*

Clara Bow

Clara Gordon Bow (July 29, 1905 – September 27, 1965) was an American actress and sex symbol who rose to fame in the silent film era of the 1920s. She became known as the 'It' girl, possessing a magnetism that attracted both male and female fans.

Always an avid movie fan herself, Bow won the Motion Picture Magazine's *Fame and Fortune* contest in 1921, the grand prize being a part in a film.

For her contributions to the motion picture industry, Clara Bow was given a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

John Sidney Blyth Barrymore (February 15, 1882 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania – May 29, 1942 in Los Angeles, California), was an American actor.

He gained fame as a stage actor, lauded for his portrayals of Hamlet and Richard III, and is frequently called the greatest actor of his generation. He also had a successful career in silent and talking films

He was the brother of Lionel Barrymore and Ethel Barrymore, and the grandfather of Drew Barrymore.

Mae West



Mae West (August 17, 1893 – November 22, 1980) was an American actress, playwright, screenwriter, and sex symbol.

Famous for her bawdy double entendres, West made a name for herself in vaudeville and on the stage in New York before moving to Hollywood to become a comedian, actress and writer in the motion picture industry. One of the most controversial stars of her day, West encountered many problems including censorship.

When her cinematic career ended, she continued to perform on stage, in Las Vegas, in the United Kingdom, on radio and television, and recorded Rock and Roll albums.
